Recuse him/herself from review, consideration or voting on any matter before the ARC when they have a bias for or against a person which does not allow them to be impartial, a direct personal or family financial interest in a matter or when requested to do so by a majority of all members of the ARC
 - vii. Comply with the applicable governing documents, policies and procedures of the Foundation
